

CURATORIAL OPPORTUNITY AT THE MILDRED LANE KEMPER ART MUSEUM
SAM FOX SCHOOL OF DESIGN & VISUAL ARTS
Call for Proposals

The College of Art Exhibitions Committee calls for proposals for exhibitions to be held in the Mildred Lane Kemper Art Museum's Garen Gallery in spring 2013. Faculty from the Sam Fox School are eligible to submit proposals for an original exhibition. The committee will also consider proposals to host a traveling exhibition or a collaborative project working with an outside curator.

Exhibition Proposals should contain a two-page project prospectus detailing the thesis and overall content of the exhibition as well as a preliminary exhibition checklist, including basic artwork information (artist, nationality, life dates; complete artwork titles, dates, medium, framed and unframed dimensions, and owner's name), artwork images, a preliminary budget, including a shipping estimate (we recommend contacting US Art for initial packing and shipping estimates: 866.928.7278). The College of Art Exhibitions Committee may have additional requirements or recommendations based on the specific exhibition proposed. Sabine Eckmann is available by appointment to discuss any questions you may have in putting together your proposal.

Artists, designers, and architects included in the exhibition must have a significant national and international exhibition record. To avoid any conflict of interest, exhibitions proposed must not include artwork by faculty, staff, students, University trustees, or other members of the University community.

Proposals are due to John Foughty, the Museum's administrative coordinator, at Campus Box 1214 (Kemper 208) by October 1, 2011.
